If you are a lesbian and fighting to recover from the disease of addiction, this may be the place for you. Come out and find out what it is all about. Discover a new, more positive, You!

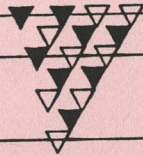

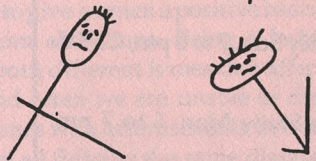

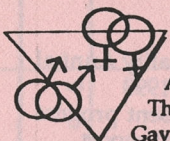
