








# Guelph Pride Get Your Pride On!








## Ryan Major


### **Heather Mclean**

Melissa Ferrick could blow her own horn quite well - a flugelhorn to be exact - if she chose. Instead, she expresses her creative spirit with an acoustic guitar. Since the early 1990s, the accomplished singer-songwriter from New England has compiled a solid string of sonically strong, lyrically rich studio albums. Often described as folk singer, Ferrick's inspiration flows from a love of rock...n' roll. During her impassioned live performances for instance, she'll occasionally crack out a Zeppelin-style riff or tinker with a little Red Hot Chili Peppers vocal improvisation. These touches however, only sharpen the intensity of her wildly popular live shows. Ferrick ranks among an elite group of female guitarists who'll brave the stage alone, and leave it with the house cheering for more.
